# RESOLUTION OF THE HANOVER AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT OF HANOVER TOWNSHIP, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING

# THE NEGOTIATION, EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT AND RELATED LEASE/PURCHASE

# AGREEMENT WITH COMMONWEALTH ENERGY GROUP LLC.

#### FOR

#### IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS DISTRICT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, The Guaranteed Energy Savings Act (GESA) of Pennsylvania authorizes municipalities and school districts to enter into contracts ("Energy Performance Contracts") for the provision of energy services, including but not limited to, electricity, in which a person agrees to install, maintain or manage energy systems or equipment to improve the energy efficiency of, or produce energy in connection with, a building or facility in exchange for a portion of the energy savings or revenues; and

WHEREAS, Hanover Area School District (the "District") issued a Request for Proposal for a performance-based energy savings and operations plan for District facilities; and

WHEREAS, Based on the District's evaluation of proposals, Commonwealth Energy Group, LLC. ("Commonwealth Energy") was selected to develop and implement a performance-based energy savings and operations plan; and

WHEREAS, Commonwealth Energy has provided the District with detailed information which sets forth design plans for improvements of various facilities of Hanover Area School District including: Hanover Area Jr/Sr. High School, Memorial Elementary, Hanover Green Elementary, Lee Park Elementary and Lyndwood Elementary by performing upgrades and conservation measures (when applicable) to the lighting upgrades and energy savings estimates and proposed financing plans for a base project as outlined in the project summary report dated February 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The District now intends to authorize the negotiation, execution and delivery of one or more Energy Performance Contracts and any other necessary agreements in an aggregate original principal and interest amount not to exceed \$810,965.62, plus, reasonable costs of issuances in connection therewith; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the District Board of Education of Hanover Area, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The District is hereby authorized to enter into an Energy Performance Contract, other agreements in an aggregate original principal and interest amount not to exceed \$810,965.62, plus reasonable costs of issuance therewith (the "Agreements") pursuant to which Commonwealth Energy will provide equipment, capital improvements, repairs, and other services to improve the energy efficiency and environmental conditions of facilities of the various District facilities.

Section 2. The School Board President, is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and deliver on behalf of the District the Agreements and all other certificates or instruments required in connection therewith provided, however, that all amounts payable by the District pursuant to the Agreements shall be subject to annual appropriation of such payments by the District's Board. The power to prescribe the terms, forms and covenants of the Agreements is hereby delegated to the School Board President.

Section 3. This resolution is not subject to a mandatory or permissive referendum.

Section 4. All acts previously taken by the District with respect to the execution and delivery of the Agreements are hereby further authorized, with the assistance of, and subject to the approval of the District's Attorney, ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
