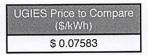

- 3. Quantity: UGIES shall sell and deliver the full requirements Power usage for the account(s) listed in this Confirmation Agreement. The Contract Quantity shown above is an estimate of the Customer's full requirements Power usage based on historical data and/or information provided by the Customer.
- 4. The Contract Price quoted above is based on Customer's estimated usage of Electricity for the accounts shown. If a material change in Customer's Electricity usage at its facilities occurs for reasons other than variations in weather (including, but not limited to, the shut-down of any existing facility, the opening of any new facility, installation or removal of equipment or changes in operating times or processes), then UGIES may charge Customer UGIES' prevailing market price at the Point of Delivery for Customer's increased Electricity usage and may assess liquidation charges to Customer calculated under UGIES' prevailing market price at the Point of Delivery for Electricity that Customer failed to consume.
- 5. Finalization of this Confirmation Agreement is subject to customer credit approval.
- 6. Pricing does not include any applicable taxes.
- 7. Contract Prices are valid for the Offer Date only. UGIES reserves the right to invalidate any Confirmation Agreement returned after the Offer Date.
- 8. In the event that the EDC or PJM: (i) implements a mandatory service for suppliers; (ii) changes transmission or capacity charges from the amounts included in the Contract Price; or (iii) adopts any other changes in its tariff requirements or changes in Customer's capacity and/or transmission obligations, and such occurrence results in a material change in costs (upward or downward) to UGIES in providing service to Customer, UGIES may adjust the Contract Price (upward or downward, as appropriate) to Customer to reflect Customer's proportional share of such material change in costs (without markup). Customer acknowledges that the Contract Price stated above may be adjusted from time to time in accordance with this provision, agrees to be responsible for such revised level of the Contract Price.
- The Contract Price is not regulated by Customer's state public utility commission ("PUC") or the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"). The PUC regulates
 distribution prices and services of the EDC.
- 10. Notwithstanding any provision in the Contract or this Confirmation Agreement, a Small Business Customer, defined as a customer that (1) is located in Pennsylvania, and (2) experienced a maximum registered peak load less than 25 kW within the last 12 months, may rescind this Confirmation Agreement within three business days of a Customer's execution date without any obligation.

We do this by pledging a pool of qualified securities to secure jointly the deposits of many local government units pursuant to the Act. Pooled collateral is permitted in accordance with the requirements of 72 P.S. §3836-1, et seq. In addition, PA Act 72 of 1971 was amended by PA Act 139 of 2000 to permit depository institutions to secure its public funds deposits with a Federal Home Loan Bank letter of credit rather than with a pledge of collateral. Under PA Act 72 of 1971 FNCB Bank advises you of the following information:

FNCB Bank has a pool of pledged assets that secures public funds deposits that exceed the current coverage limit for accounts provided by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

As of December 31, 2022, this pool of pledged assets includes securities having a total par valuation of \$363.3 million and a market valuation of \$330.2 million, which is consistently maintained in an adequate position to secure public funds. As of December 31, 2022, total public funds on deposit with FNCB Bank secured by these assets totaled \$316.7 million.

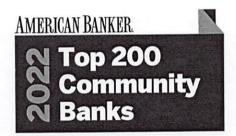
