## Rapid Antigen Testing

To Parent/Guardian of students under the age of 18,

At Hanover Area School District, we seek to maintain a safe environment for employees, students, families, and the community. To support those goals, we have partnered with Concentric by Ginkgo to provide an optional and free COVID testing program.

But first, we need your help! Should your student develop symptoms while attending school, we will have the ability with your permission, to test for COVID before they leave the building. We are requesting each family to participate in this program to help safeguard the wellbeing of our entire school community.

To get started, please fill out the consent form with your permission to perform a COVID-19 test for your student at Hanover Area School District. This process should take no more than 5 minutes to complete using a computer or a smartphone.
